The Institute for Public Law, Dep. 2 is seeking to appoint at the beginning of 1st March 2020

Research Assistants (m/f/d), 25–100 % position(s) for up to two PhD students,

for the research project "Data Access and Data Use in Medical Institutional and Consumer Health Settings: An Ethical, Legal, and Social Analysis".

The Research Assistant will collaborate and do research on the legal and ethical part of the project, which forms part of an interesting and promising interdisciplinary field of research. This also offers the opportunity to embark on a doctoral research project.

The legal and ethical part of the interdisciplinary project, funded by the Federal Ministry of Research, focuses on provisions relevant for access and use of health related data for research purposes. In addition to an analysis of the legal framework consisting of German constitutional law, EU primary law, the General Data Protection Regulation and soft law, this includes examining the procedural legitimacy of Data Use and Access Committees.

- Required is a German state examination in Law (with distinction) or an equivalent foreign legal qualification.
- If you are participating in a current state examination campaign you can equally apply just with the results of the written part and the university part and hand in the overall result later.

Interest in and willingness to participate in interdisciplinary work, good command of English and knowledge in the field of data protection law, constitutional law, European law or philosophy of law are advantageous.

It is possible to negotiate on the appointment of a Postdoc (completed Ph.D. or S.J.D. or J.D. required), if you are interested.

The university and the institute aim to increase the proportion of women in research and therefore encourage suitably qualified women to apply. Persons with severe disabilities will receive a preferential treatment if other qualifications are the same.
