#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must hold or expect to receive a degree from an ABA-approved law school or from a recognized law faculty outside the United States before matriculating in the LLM program at UConn School of Law. Applicants must supply:

- Personal statement and writing sample
- Resume or CV
- TOEFL, IELTS or PTE language test results
- Two recommendation letters
- All degree transcripts

#### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Completion of 24 credits, including two required courses: U.S. Law and Legal Institutions and U.S. Law and Legal Research and Writing
- Completion of one LLM writing requirement

#### COST:

- \$1,190 per credit for Energy and Environmental Law, Human Rights and Social Justice and U.S. Legal Studies.
- \$1,326 per credit for Insurance Law
